# Central Skagit Rural Partial County Library District Public Hearing on the 2016 Budget Proposal November 19, 2015 7:00 p.m.

- 1. Call to order on Public Hearing on the 2016 Budget Proposal
- 2. Public Comments
  - Sylvia Matterand applauded the fact that the library (CSRPCLD) had had previous discussions with Sedro-Woolley city officials and library staff. She stated that she hopes these talks will continue towards a partnership of the two libraries. She also mentioned she was glad to hear that the bookmobile was not part of the 2016 budget proposal. Mrs. Matterand expressed her opinion that the CSRPCLD tax is too high and she would like to please see it lowered. She inquired about whether or not the budget proposal for next year would be adjusted according to a possible partnership with the Sedro-Woolley City Library.
  - Donna Vance spoke about the tax rate and asked that it be lowered. She expressed her opinion that online resources do not make sense for those who live in rural areas. Mrs. Vance believes that the library should budget more for physical books as opposed to electronic databases. She would like to see the city library merge with the CSRPCLD.
  - Susan Trout, an avid reader and former patron of Mount Vernon and the Sedro-Woolley City Library, believes that there is potential to be "phenomenal" if CSRPCLD would partner with the city. She is concerned about overspending, especially on a brand new building. She does not like the fact that there are now two separate libraries with unshared materials. She stated that the ballot said up to \$.50 per thousand, but she did not realize it could start out at that rate.
  - Duane Whittle expressed his concern about the library tax being too high. He was unaware that the library existed or that there was a tax levy vote for a rural library until recently. Mr. Whittle mentioned that he feels as though he is paying too much for the CSRPCLD. His children used the high school library because he did not want to pay for a membership at the Sedro-Woolley City Library.
  - Sharon Howe stated that from the start the city should have partnered with CSRPCLD. She pointed out, however, that it is now

"water under the bridge". Mrs. Howe explained that she now has a better understanding of the process and the legal complications of working towards a partnership with the city library. She stressed that she does not want to see overspending and that needs should outweigh wants.

- Katy Janicki expressed a concern that many people in the rural library district are "in the dark" about the direction in which the library is going. She believes a partnership with the city library would be beneficial.
- John Janicki stressed his view that a consolidation of services and materials is better than a duplication of library services and materials. Mr. Janicki also mentioned that "what people heard" about the tax levy vote to establish the rural library was much "different from what turned out". He expressed that people did not think there would be two libraries so near to each other.
- 3. Chairman Mindy Coslor recessed the meeting at 7:20pm.
