2. Public Comments

Bob Abrams – shared that he was disappointed in the book culling process as a series that he was reading (The Borrowers) was removed from the collection before he was finished reading it. He said he hoped staff would make sure that patrons aren't reading a series that is being removed. He also said that he was shocked to learn that the architect was telling the public that 20,000 to 30,000 items would be removed.

Wayne Carlson – shared that he had attended the public meeting about the new library design and thought it would be great if the library could work with Skagit Transit to have the library as a stop for Dial-a-Ride and transit, particularly for those in wheelchairs and walkers. He also shared that he had forgotten to look to see if the staff would have lines of sight to the bathroom entrances. He stated that he had a friend who had walked in on illegal activities in a bathroom at Burlington Library and he was hoping that staff would be able to see the bathroom entrances to help limit illegal or inappropriate bathroom usage.

Jeanne Williams spent a great deal of time over the last month looking at the collection statistics for age and circulation. Over the last three months no more than 6-7% of the collection is checked out at any given time. The goal is to get the collection up to 20% or more checked out at any given time. 12% of the collection has not checked out at all in 5 years or more. 66% of the nonfiction was published in 2007 or earlier. Older legal and medical materials are dangerous due to outdated information and should not be given away or sold. Non-fiction will be updated.

Circulation statistics show that since March, as a consolidated library, there has been a 21% increase in circulation compared to that of each of the libraries separately.

Technology updates of staff computers, firewall, server and security cameras have been completed. Security cameras are not accessible to any other entity or person outside of the library. A recent major power outage damaged the patron computers, so those will be replaced.

Friends of the Library are being overwhelmed with discarded books and donations. They have reached out to local schools, churches and civic organizations to offer free books. Thus far there has not been much interest. Better World Books also has limitations on what they will accept in used books. The reality is that some books will need to be recycled.

Two new databases will be up and running in the following weeks. One is an up to date travel guide (like Frommer's) as well as a world food guide.

Over the last few months, several patrons and groups have contacted me to find out if they could use the Metcalf location for meetings, studying, etc. because the Ball Street location is so busy and so small that it cannot accommodate. This indicates a need for these types of spaces.

Ahmik Hindman asked if the recent payment to SirsiDynix was the penalty fee and Jeanne Williams stated that he was correct.

Darcy Resetar shared that she and her family have really enjoyed using the library this summer, especially all of the activities and events for all ages. She has enjoyed the adult summer reading bingo.

Mary Alice Grobins shared that she toured the garden area and was impressed with the work being done by patrons, staff and volunteers and hopes that the new library facility can have a similar garden area.

Unfinished Business

A. New Library Update and Upcoming Joint Meetings (Information)

The 30% design meeting took place, but no boards from that meeting are on display because of the changes being made to internal spaces and exterior look. There is a great deal of work going on with the site design with the city of Sedro-Woolley (water lines, power poles, fire/EMS access, etc.) The next joint meeting will be on October 3rd for 60% design. Architectural drawings and schematics will follow that with the hope to bid the project in early 2019.

Mary Alice Grobins shared that there have been questions about collection size in the new building, appropriate collection for the population, and collection space for growth in the future.

Jeanne Williams shared that one cannot equate floor space with the number of volumes that will fit in a building. What was not apparent in the design drawings is that there would be 200 feet more in linear feet of shelving. Current population is approximately 26,000 and at a 2 per capita formula, an appropriate collection size would be approximately 52,000. Libraries serving this size population in this state have materials per capita numbers ranging from 1.6 to 2.5 per capita. The current shelving plan in the new library design will accommodate 61,000-63,000 items, which will allow for growth over 20 years. Another factor that will affect collection space needs is the rising circulation of electronic materials. While Central Skagit Library is in a growth phase and is seeing rising physical materials circulation, most surrounding libraries and libraries throughout the state are seeing declining physical materials circulation. Libraries are beginning to shift spending away from physical materials and towards electronic materials and this library may one day see that same shift. Finally, with a more updated collection, it is likely that a higher percentage of items will be checked out at any given time, which frees up shelving space.

Mary Alice Grobins asked if her understanding that the current collection of about 61,000 items could be picked up and moved into the new library based on current linear feet plans is correct. Jeanne Williams stated that this understanding is correct. Mary Alice Grobins furthered that, if the newer collection reached the higher percentage checked out, such as 20%, then this would also require less shelving overall.

B. Committee Update on Director Evaluation

Darcy Resetar shared the work that she and Mindy Coslor had done regarding the Director Evaluation. They met with Catherine McHugh by phone to discuss the timing and the evaluation tool. Catherine shared several tools with them to aid them in creating one for the library district. Darcy further shared that she would be sending out a survey to get input from the Trustees and the director on the competencies to include in the tool.

C. Recommendation of State Holiday Pay

Jeanne Williams provided a memo (Appendix 1) with a recommendation on state holiday pay for those who may work on a state holiday. The recommendation included allowing double-time pay for those who do regular library work, such as checking book drops and otherwise checking on the library, on a state holiday. However, those who wish to participate in civic events on state holidays will do so only on a volunteer basis and not in as an employee on library time.

A. 2018 Budget Amendment Resolution (Appendix 2)

Jeanne Williams explained the reason there would need to be a budget amendment. The addition of \$35,400 to the 2018 budget would reflect the actual amount paid to the shared construction account with the city of Sedro-Woolley. Originally it was misunderstood that the payments would begin with the consolidation date of February 19th. However, the payments began immediately following the effective date of the Library Partnership Interlocal Agreements in December of 2017. The addition of \$316,563 would cover the purchase of the Iron Skillet property for the new library facility project.

MEMO TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

RE: Recommendation on State Holiday Pay

On June 21, 2018, the Board of Trustees discussed options for paying out Holiday Pay when staff work on state holidays. There were two issues addressed with regard to working in this capacity:

- 1. Working onsite to handle library business
- 2. Participating in civic events on paid state holidays

In reviewing the practices of other public entities in Skagit County, it was found that some Boards (or union contracts) specified that employees working on a paid state holiday doing normal work duties would be paid double time their rate of pay only if the work was authorized by a supervisor.

However, activities in civic events representing those organizations was not specifically covered. In the discussions on June 21, 2018, the issue of liability for the library district was a concern. After the July 4, 2017 Loggerodeo Parade, I had a meeting with our local Enduris Insurance representative and he shared that parades are inherently risky and that very specific policies would need to be put in place to limit that risk. Further in the discussion, some examples of other organizations were shared where employees could volunteer to take part in civic events for promotion, but those activities often took place with the work of other volunteer organizations related to the organization for which they worked.

In my view, staff should be allowed to take the state holiday without feeling as though they must participate in civic events. State holidays allow for staff to spend time with family and friends. I am also concerned about the liability the library district takes on when staff participate in civic activities while on paid time.

My recommendation to the Board is to allow for double-time pay to those employees who do work on a state holiday for regular library business, only if authorized by the Director. The types of activities that this would entail include checking book drops so that they do not overfill and otherwise checking on the library if the alarm is triggered. These activities would be very minimal, infrequent, and generally take an hour or less to complete. My recommendation to the Board with regard to civic events on state holidays is not to allow paid time work for promotional activities on these holidays. This does not rule out the opportunity for employees to volunteer to work with a Friends of the Library group to do promotional activities, but this would be done only with Friends of the Library sponsorship if the Friends of the Library choose to do so.

My recommendation to the Board with regard to civic events on state holidays is not to allow paid time work for promotional activities on these holidays. Activities

- Skagit Reads discussions have been going on among Directors and the staff people involved. It will take place in the Fall (September/October). The book has been chosen and activities are being planned. Central Skagit will be contributing to an author visit that will take place in La Conner and will be giving out copies of the book *The Soul of an Octopus* by Sy Montgomery. The book club will be reading the book in the fall. In the past we have contributed \$200-\$300.
- July 23rd Met with Sergeant Paul Eaton of the Sedro-Woolley Police Department to discuss the challenges libraries face serving a diverse public. There has been particular concern over people sleeping or using the patio area at night and we agreed to turn off WiFi during the late night and early morning hours. It is understood that using the library WiFi late at night could be dangerous for patrons who might not be aware of surroundings. If we find that patrons complain that they need the services outside of the hours, we will revisit. The WiFi at Metcalf will remain on 24 hours and we are letting patrons know.
- July 31st Met with Isaac Huffman (Mt. Vernon Library Director) to discuss ways
 that our libraries could collaborate on programming, particularly with Skagit
 Reads. A first draft of an interlocal agreement for reciprocal borrowing has been
 submitted to the Mt. Vernon city attorney for advisement. We hope to see
 reciprocal borrowing in place by the end of this year. We also discussed a
 timeline for creating a consortium to bring Mt. Vernon Library into our ILS
 database to facilitate lending between the two libraries. We will begin the process
 in mid-2019 for an early 2020 migration.
- August 2nd Met with Ruth Barefoot (Anacortes Library Director) and Sarah Ward (Burlington Library Director) to discuss training opportunities for front-line staff and to discuss ways to organize around a shared set of goals for all of the library directors. We also discussed the possibilities that could facilitate the movement of materials among the libraries: shared ILS, staff courier of items, use of OCLC if shared ILS is not possible.

Donations

A patron who did not wish to be named donated \$4800 and asked that we spend
it on materials such as best sellers and other popular items. She shared that she
had been using the library for over 30 years and was very happy with the
changes we'd made to the library and the reading room.

 The Friends of the Library donated \$1300 to help pay for Summer Reading Program supplies, food and incentives.

Expense Report Overages - Operational

- Software and Licensing Since we have gained about 10,000+ in population served, all of the licensing for digital services increased in price. For example, Washington Anytime Library increased by \$4800, up from \$6800. Also, we are seeing very high usage on the Hoopla service-which is a pay per use service. I believe this is worth it because this is easing the pressure on our collection-particularly the DVDs and audiobooks. Moving forward this line item will be will be approximately double what we have paid annually thus far.
- Furniture and Equipment overage here was expected when we consolidated
 the libraries and had to replace aged and broken furniture and shelving to
 maintain the library's functional use and welcoming environment that we had
 achieved prior to the move.
- Professional Services the overage in this one-time expenditures category is primarily due to the electrical upgrade and the labor to move and build the shelving that was in storage.
- Library Materials by the end of the year, this line item amount may be exceeded due to the replacement costs involved with updating the non-fiction collection.

Ongoing and Upcoming Activities

- Summer Reading Program statistics will be ready for the September meeting.
- Skagit Directors will be meeting at the end of August to talk about formalizing the group and developing clear goals for collaboration and resource-sharing.
- I will be working on the 2019 Budget for a first look in September. I will sharing some of the assumptions I will be working under later in the meeting.
- I will be attending an Enduris workshop on sexual harassment policy on August 15th.
- Currently have a job announcement out for a full-time circulation and technology
 person and will be reviewing applications and interviewing at the end of the
 month. I am looking for someone who will be able to help patrons on the
 computers and with apps and mobile devices and to help Ricardo with future
 technology workshops for patrons. This will free up some of our other employees
 to work on major projects such as collection maintenance, inventory and
 labeling/re-labeling.
